Notes regarding Gift Aid

Under the Gift Aid scheme, the University of Buckingham is able to claim back the basic rate of tax you have already paid on your money, thereby increasing the value of your gift to the University at no extra cost to you.

1. In order to be eligible, you must pay an amount of income tax and/or capital gains tax at least equal to the tax that the charity reclaims on your donations in the tax year.
2. If you pay tax at the higher rate of 40%, you can claim further relief in your Self-Assessment return; ask your tax advisor or tax office for further information.
3. You can cancel this declaration at any time by notifying the Development Office
4. If in the future your circumstances change and you no longer pay tax on your income and capital gains equal to the tax that the charity reclaims, please notify the Foundation Office and we will cancel your declaration.
